What are cookies

Cookies are small text files that are placed on your computer, tablet, smartphone, smartTVs or other devices by websites, web portals and applications that you visit. They are widely used in order to recognise your device, record some aspect of a website and to provide information to the owners of the website on your preferences or past actions.

The rules on cookies are covered by the EU e-Privacy Directive. Google Analytics	_utma, _utmb, _utmc, _utmz	These cookies are used to collect information about how visitors use our site. We use the information to compile reports and to help us improve the site. The cookies collect information in an anonymous form, including the number of visitors to the site, where visitors have come to the site from and the pages they visited. Site cookie acceptance	cookies-allowed	This cookie is used to record that a user has accepted the use of cookies on this website. It expires after one year.	
Underlying system	PHPSESSIONID	This cookie is used by the underlying system
